**2nd Round Porsche Mobil 1 Supercup – Barcelona (ESP)
 Another strong weekend for Konrad Motorsport**

With the second rank of Nick Tandy, who leads the driver standings tied with Sean Edwards, and with the lead in the team standings, a quite successful weekend for the 2nd round of the Porsche Mobil 1 Supercup came to an end for Konrad Motorsport. After Christian Engelhart's victory at the season opener in Istanbul it's now Nick Tandy together with his compatriot who leads the championship of Europe's fastest makes cup. Season highlight follows already next weekend in Monaco.



Two races, two podium finishes for Nick Tandy

"We are very satisfied with the weekend in Spain", Konrad pilot Nick Tandy speaks for his complete team. "To claim a second rank in the qualifying as well as in the race on a circuit on which we didn't get along at all last year is a result that let me look into the future very optimistically", the Brit despite a flu shines. "Due to the fact that Nick had struggled the complete weekend with a virus, his performance was amazing", team boss Franz Konrad praises his driver.

With a gap of only 0.072 seconds behind his compatriot Sean Edwards the Konrad-Pilot in the qualifying at the Circuit de Catalunya fetched second starting position for the race. "The best of all is that all drivers who are in front of me in the championship are far behind me in the starting grid." With the last years runner-up alludes to his team mate Christian Engelhart on eighths position. "However, I am a good starter, so I hope to still drive into the Top-5", the German thinks.

At the start of the race the Carrera of Nick Tandy came under pressure of the surprisingly strong Rookies Cuba Giermaziak and Kevin Estre, who even were able to set him back from second rank. "However, Nick was so strong, I didn't have a chance against him", his opponent Giermaziak commented on falling back to third again. "After that I had everything under control, and only had to concentrate on bringing home second place", Nick Tandy was pleased about second rank and the leadership in the Supercup together with race winner Sean Edwards. "I am quite upset", says Christian Engelhart about the driving style of an opponent. "He stepped hard on the brakes with full intention to let me crash into his back and damage my cooler." The Istanbul winner could avoid the collision but stuck in the traffic. After 14 laps the 24-year-old student of automotive engineering finished his race on ninth position. "Now I am looking forward to the season highlight in Monaco at the next weekend", he reminds that Konrad Motorsport covered second rank there last year.

Driving for the team Konrad Motorsport Austria, Mathias Lauda and Andreas Mayerl finishes their only second race for the team on positions 14 and 17. "My start was really bad, I didn't have the opportunity to practice the difficult starts with the Cup-Porsche", says the son of the former Formula 1 Champion Niki Lauda. "We will work exactly on this issue with Mathias and Andreas, who also loses positions due to a bad start", team manager Franz Konrad announces Tests for the two drivers.

However, at first the team travels to the season highlight of the Supercup in Monaco. "Fortunately all four cars escaped any accidents in Barcelona, so we can go to Monaco completely relaxed", Franz Konrad as well as the complete team is pleased about some eased days.
