### 3rd Round Porsche Mobil 1 Supercup - Monaco Two times on Top – Konrad Motorsport leads driver- and team standings

With a second rank at the Monaco Grand Prix Konrad driver Nick Tandy takes over the lead in the Porsche Mobil 1 Supercup. The flawless performance of the Brit and the twelfth rank of Christian Engelhart in the narrow streets of the principality secured the lead for Konrad Motorsport also in the team standings. Andreas Mayerl wins the rookie classification.

"It's always something very special to have a podium finish in Monaco. Success leaves its marks", Franz Konrad was pleased that his driver Nick Tandy with a second rank could take over the lead in the driver standings of the Supercup. In the qualifying Tandy put his Konrad-Porsche into the first row of the starting grid alongside his all time rival René Rast. "To start at the highlight of the year from the front row of the grid is a good achievement, although I was kind of distracted on the last meters of my

qualifying lap by an opponent. Maybe I even could have been a little quicker and with that on pole position", the runner-up of the last year commented on the qualifying. Team mate Christian Engelhart had to settle with thirteen's position in the starting grid. "I was too quick at the exit of the Casino corner and so I hit the barriers", admits the winner of the season opener in Istanbul.

Although Nick Tandy celebrated one of his good starts in the 16 laps of the race in the narrow streets on Monaco, he got under pressure in the first corner. The young Poland Kuba Giermaziak had a good start as well, attacked Tandy in St. Devote, but finally had to settle behind the Brit. "After that little incident the positions were taken", Tandy makes clear, that overtaking is nearly impossible in Monaco. "I tried to attack and put some pressure on René (Rast), but leading the race, he didn't make a mistake." Like his rival, Tandy did what he had to do in Monaco and stood free of any faults and saw the chequered flag on second position. "With that I am in lead of the driver standings of the Supercup for the first time – that's a really good feeling", he comments his two points lead on his compatriot Sean Edwards. "Christian Engelhart stuck in the traffic, what is quite typical for the Monaco race", says team manager Franz Konrad. "Nevertheless he fetched some valuable points and with that he secured the lead for Konrad Motorsport also in the team standings of the championship",

Driving under the entry Konrad Motorsport Austria Andreas Mayerl and Mathias Lauda finished fourteens and fifteens in the field of 24 starters. "Both had a good performance and delivered a good show for the fans", team boss Konrad praises the two. "I fulfilled the task I got from the team manager. The car is still in one piece and above all, I was even able to collect some points", Mayerl was pleased. Finishing fourteens Mayerl was also the best rookie driver of the Monaco round. "We have battled over the complete race distance", says team mate Lauda. "I could have gone quicker than him, but I didn't find a way to pass him." Two times the son of Niki Lauda tried to make a move, but every time he had to settle behind his team mate.

Already at the next weekend Konrad Motorsport starts at the third round of the German Carrera Cup in Spielberg (AUT). "That's were I was born and raised", Konrad alludes to his Austrian roots. "With Nick Tandy we want to maintain our lead in the German Carrera Cup at our home race."
